CDP's mission

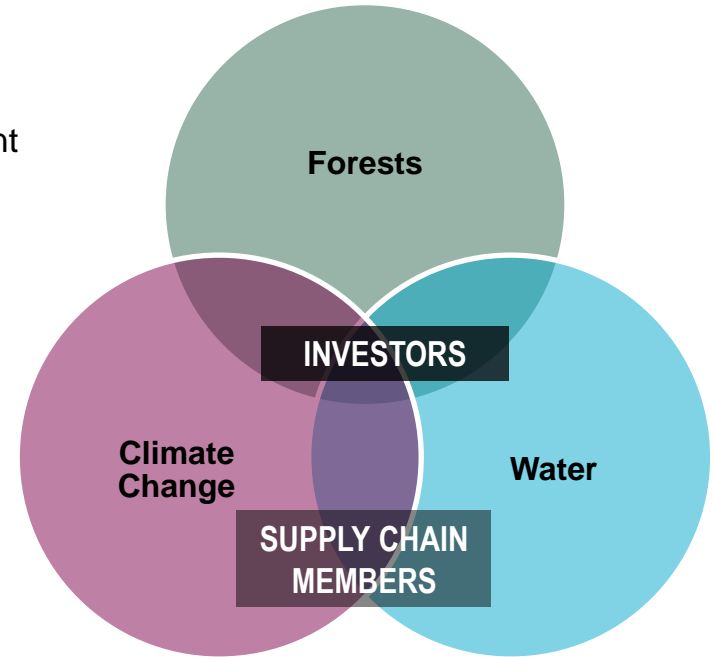
- To transform the global economic system to prevent dangerous climate change and value our natural resources by putting relevant information at the heart of business, investment and policy decisions

CDP collects information on:

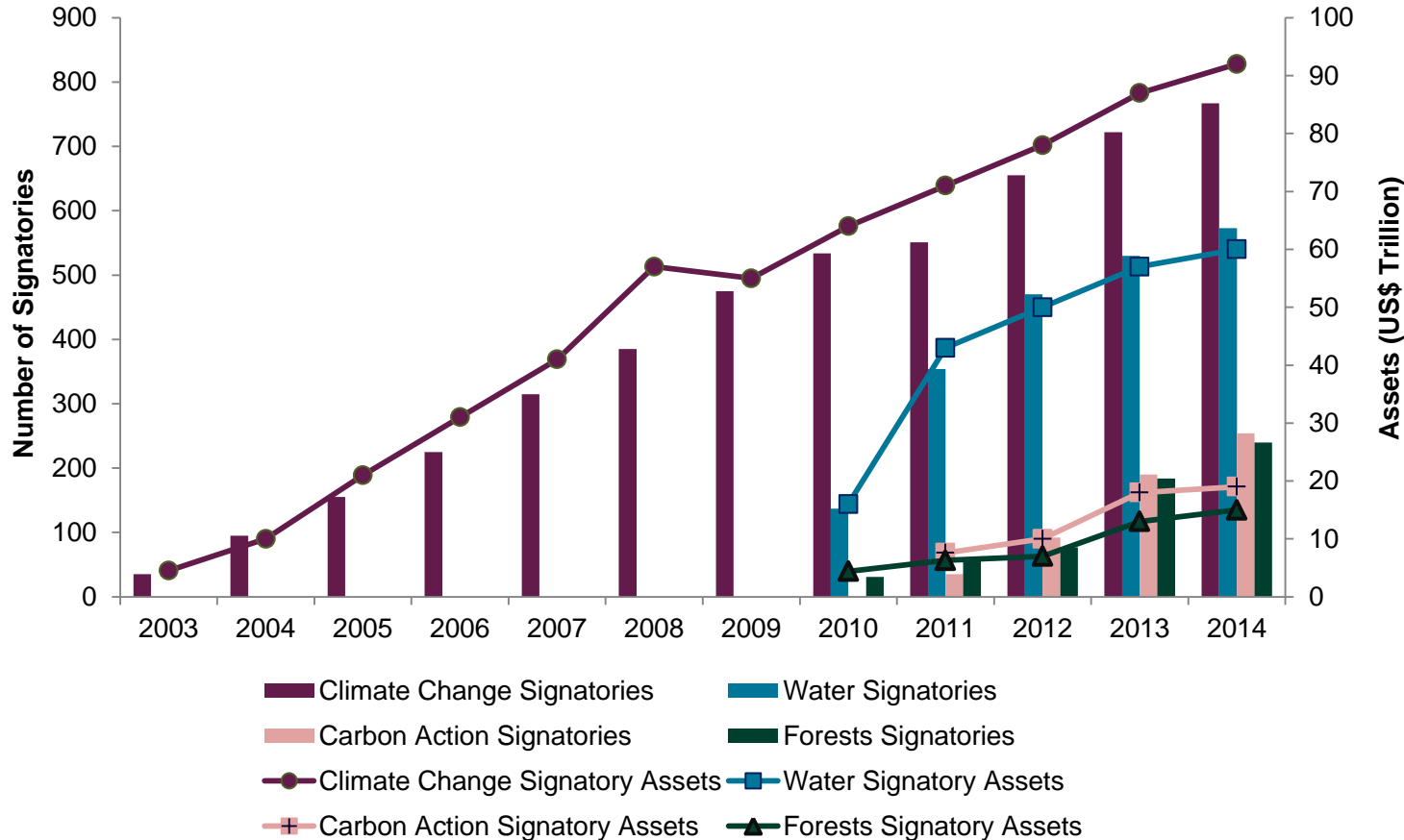
- Climate Change

Signatories & Assets under management, 2003-14

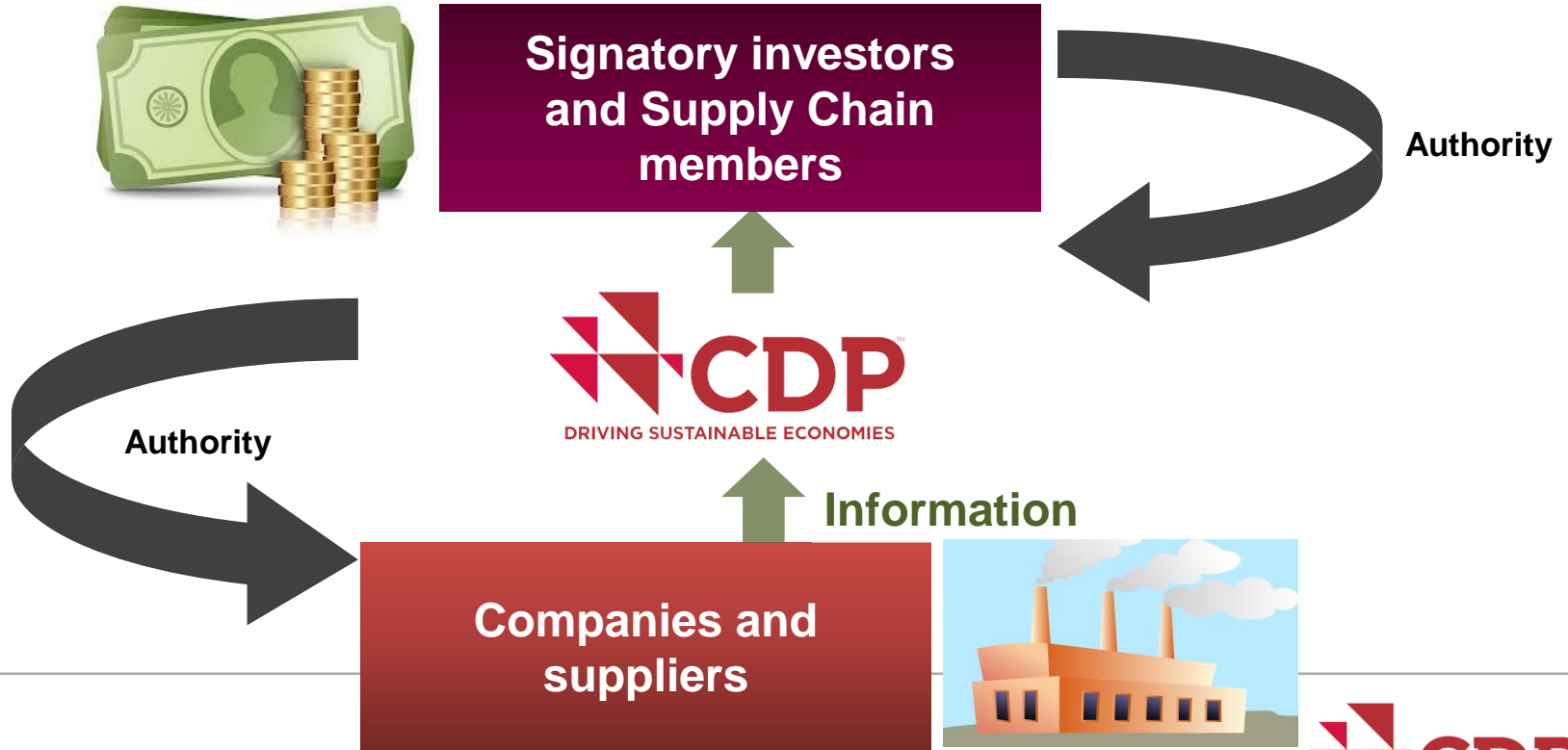
